VENUE

Prospecta Americas will take place at Hidalgo Science and Technology Park (PCYTH), located at: Boulevard Circuito de la Concepción #3, Colonia ExHacienda la Concepción, San Agustín Tlaxiaca, Hidalgo, C.P. 42162, Mexico.

DATES

The Seminar will be held on Wednesday, May 18th and Thursday May 19th, 2022 between 9:00 am and 6:00 pm (time in Central Mexico). It is recommended for international speakers and participants to arrive on Tuesday May 17th, 2022.

LANGUAGE

The event will be held in English and Spanish. Simultaneous interpretation will be available on the Live Webcast of the event on two channels – one in English and one in Spanish.

TARGET AUDIENCE

The seminar is aimed at entrepreneurs, researchers, academics, postgraduate students, private sector leaders, high-level authorities and public officials from all over the Americas, as well as from other parts of the World, interested in collaborating on future studies, technology foresight and transformative technologies.

AIRFARES

Each participant or their supporting institution will be responsible for covering their airfares from their place of residence to the City of Pachuca in the State of Hidalgo, Mexico.

It is recommended for international speakers and participants to arrive at Mexico City International Airport "Benito Juárez" (AICM).

TRANSPORTATION AIRPORT-HOTEL-AIRPORT

From Mexico City International Airport (AICM), it is possible to purchase bus tickets and to board buses directly from the terminal to the City of Pachuca, Hidalgo. The approximate duration of the transfer is 1.5 hours.

Other options to consider include Uber and Cabify. Both services are available in Mexico City through their respective smartphone apps, however, due to security policies at Mexico City International Airport (AICM), it is not possible to request these services to pick you up directly at the airport.

HOTEL

The hotel where international speakers and participants will stay during the program is the Holiday Inn Express Hotel located at: Boulevard Luis Donaldo Colosio 220 Fracc, Arboledas de San Javier, 42084 Pachuca de Soto, Hidalgo.

ENTERING MEXICO

To enter Mexico, each traveler must comply with the immigration requirements and procedures. All travelers must have a valid passport with at-least 6 month remaining before it expires.

As of March 2022, it is no longer necessary to present a PCR test or to fill out a health questionnaire to fly to/from Mexico. However, all passengers are requested to cooperate and continue to comply with health protection measures in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic.

MEALS

During the Seminar, refreshments and/or coffee breaks will be offered in various rooms and spaces of the Hidalgo Science and Technology Park, in accordance with the program.

Also during the event, food trucks will be parked outside the Science and Technology Park (PCYTH) with various types of food and beverages available, so that participants can buy and consume their lunch on premises.

Each participant is responsible for assuming the expenses related to their food consumption.

HEALTH INSURANCE

It is recommended that all international attendees purchase travel insurance in case of a health emergency, under the responsibility of each participant.

It is also recommended for those who take specific or prescription medication to bring a sufficient quantity to last them for the entire duration of their stay.

COVID-19

In Mexico, health officials of the federal government have authorized the holding of public events to resume work, social, educational, cultural and economic activities in the country, while adhering to strict minimum safety standards against the risk of COVID-19 contagion.

Therefore, during the Seminar, it is recommended that all participants wear face masks in closed spaces (meetings rooms and auditoriums); wash their hands frequently with soap and water, or use a 70% gel alcohol-based solution; and where feasible, keep a healthy distance between individuals during breaks and networking events. Vaccinated people should also bring a copy (paper or digital) of their vaccination certificate with them.

The Ministry of Health of Hidalgo will be present during the Seminar to support the application of health measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19, and attend any health emergency, including providing COVID-19 detection tests if necessary.

DRESS CODE

The dress code for the event is “business-casual”. The temperature in the City of Pachuca for the month of May ranges between 24°C and 28°C during the day and between 7°C and 13°C at night.

ELECTRIC PLUGS

The electrical connectors in Mexico are type A and B plugs. It is recommended that participants verify the compatibility of their technologies with these types of plugs and bring adapters if necessary.
